

**Minutes of the Review Meeting of OUIDF Funded Projects held on 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2017 at 04:00 P.M.  
in the Conference Hall of H&UD Department, Secretariat**

Commissioner-cum-Secretary, H&UD Department presided over the Meeting. After a detailed review, the following observations were made and decisions taken:

**General Observations:**

- Monthly Billing Cycle has to be ensured for all OUIDF funded Projects. The culture of monthly billing, prompt payments to contractors, completion of project within schedule shall be nurtured for OUIDF projects.
- Toilets to be constructed at Water Body sites.

**Modern Abattoir at Gadakana, Bhubaneswar**

- Project should be fully functional by Mid-August 2017 and Trial Runs completed with operationalization of all facilities during August 2017.
- Modern Abattoir to be dedicated to the people of Bhubaneswar on or before 31<sup>st</sup> August 2017
- e-Tendering for O&M Operator to be completed immediately
- The modern abattoir project shall be replicated in other ULBs after taking key learning inputs from the Gadakana project.

**Sambalpur Fish Market at Danipali and Kamali Bazaar**

- SMC to operationalize the Fish Market at Danipalli
- E-Tender to be floated for ETP at both the Fish Markets

**Reclamation of 14 Water Bodies at Bhubaneswar**

- BMC to expedite the progress of Sunderpada and Fisheries Tank to ensure that the progress of work is as per schedule.

**Reclamation of Water Bodies at Sambalpur**

- Tender to be floated for balance work at Dhama Road Water Body.
- OUIDF to review the Tender Documents of SMC to check if there are any limiting clauses that restricts participation of Bidders.

**Augmentation of Water Supply to Gopalpur NAC**


- Budgetary Allocation status for Gopalpur and Berhampur Water Supply including Interest payment to OUIDF to be taken up by Special Secretary, H&UDD.

**Reclamation of Water Bodies at Berhampur**

- BeMC to submit complete set of Tender documents for approval by H&UDD.

**Branding of OUIDF**

- The Logo of OUIDF may be re-edited incorporating symbolic representation of Water Supply and Sewerage etc., such as blue line with a tap.
- The Information Board shall incorporate tangible output, such as no. of bathing facilities, seats, toilets etc.
- The Board shall be in Odia language also.
